Please write your first and last name on all supplies.

• 3 black or blue pens • 2 boxes of 24 pencils • 1 package of multi-colored pens for their interactive math notebooks (ex: Bic colored pens/Flair pens) • 9 composition notebooks (no metal spirals) (3 blue, 2 green, 1 yellow, 1 black speckled, and 2 red) *(No plastic/flimsy covers, please. Cardboard ones are preferred)* • Chinese Class - 1 RED sturdy folder (no binders) AND 1 composition notebook (they can reuse from last year) • Art Class - 5 additional glue sticks (These will be used in the Art room.) • 2 - two-pack of fine-tip Sharpies (One pack will be given to the art teacher.) • Ultra fine tip <i>black</i> Sharpies • 1 STURDY (of your choice design) folder as the "Take Home Folder" (no red) • 5 rolls of scotch tape in a plastic dispenser.
