- ☐ 1 pack of **CONSTRUCTION PAPER** in **ASSORTED COLORS**
- ☐ 1 solid-colored **2 POCKET POLY FOLDER** with **PRONGS** - Click [here](#) for example. DO NOT label.
- ☐ 1 roll of **PAINTER'S TAPE** - any width
- ☐ **Clear SCOTCH TAPE** - rolls or refills to be used in classroom tape dispensers
- ☐ 1 box **GALLON-SIZE ZIPLOC FREEZER BAGS** - slide-locks preferred
- ☐ 1 pack of **GLUE STICKS** for Ms. S's Art Class
- ☐ 1 container **DISINFECTING WIPES***
- ☐ 2 packages **BABY WIPES*** - unscented
- ☐ 1 large box **Kleenex FACIAL TISSUES***
- ☐ 1 roll of **PAPER TOWELS***

- ☐ 1 pack **LARGE UNCOATED WHITE PAPER PLATES, 9"** - Click [here](#) for example
- ☐ 1 pack **BAND-AIDS (any brand)**, plain with no characters/designs

Please label and bring the following items:

- ☐ **COMPLETE CHANGE OF CLOTHES**** (underwear, pants, shirt, and socks) to be left at school in a gallon-size Ziploc bag with your child's name on it. ***If your child is newly potty-trained, please bring 2 complete sets plus shoes.*
- ☐ **REUSABLE WATER BOTTLE** (Preferably **FLIP TOP** and no more than 8.75" tall) – Send a reusable water bottle filled with **WATER ONLY** to school each day to have available in the classroom. No juice or other beverages, please.
- ☐ **NAP MAT or BLANKET** to use for rest time. Please bring to school every Monday and take home on Fridays to be washed. Twin-size comforters are **TOO LARGE AND BULKY** for rest time, so please send something smaller. A **beach towel** fits nicely on the cots, or you can search "**Nap Mat**" on Amazon or Target for ideas. Before school starts, help your preschooler practice folding it or rolling it up. They will need to do this each day after rest time.
- ☐ **BACKPACK** to carry items to and from school. It should fit a regular-size folder, a lunchbox (if your child is bringing their lunch), a zip-up hoodie or cardigan (for layering in the classroom), and your preschooler's rest time towel (unless they use a nap mat which usually has a handle). Typical "preschool" size backpacks are too small.
- ☐ **FAMILY PICTURE** - 4" x 6" (or smaller). If you email it to me at DLILLEY@cps.edu, I can print it out.
