7. Principal's Report

- We participated in a Network Rigor Walk on November 20, and we received positive feedback about the use of learning targets and the positive culture in our school. The rubric for the walks focuses on three pillars: learning targets, intentional group work, and monitoring student progress. We debriefed the feedback with the team and with the Instructional Leadership Team. We are considering how to conduct group work in a more structured and effective manner as we move forward.
- Our Math Curriculum Committee has begun the process of selecting a new math curriculum. We identified high quality, according to EdReports, curricula and what we are looking for. Our next step is to rate each curriculum via rubric and schedule school visits. Our goal is to choose the new curriculum by April 1.
- The social emotional theme for December is "Making a Difference". Students learn to be active citizens of their school communities by doing good deeds, helping others, and giving back to the community.

- Our overall attendance rate for the year is 94.88%, down from last month, and compared to 94.01% at this time last year, with only 2nd, 4th, 6th, and 7th grades finishing above the 95% threshold. 4th grade has the highest attendance percentage at 96.76%.
- We have collected \$24,435 in Student Fees so far, compared with \$30,580 at this time last year.
- We will host our annual primary grades Holiday Concert on Wednesday, December 18, featuring the debut of our OPS Choir.

8. Bilingual Advisory Committee Report from Mrs. Battersby, vice president

- BAC purpose is to support the parents of ELL students.
- Their budget is based off of the school's budget and is \$1250 for parent engagement.
