

# 2025-2026 Fifth Grade Supply List

**\*Please write your first and last name on all supplies.\***

- 3 black or blue pens (**erasable is preferred**)
- 2 boxes of **24 pencils**
- 1 package of multi-colored **pens** for their interactive math notebooks (ex: Bic colored pens/Flair pens)
- **7 composition** notebooks (no metal spirals) (2 blue, 1 green, 1 yellow, 1 black speckled, and 2 red )  
**\*\* (No plastic/flimsy plastic covers, please. Cardboard ones are preferred)\*\***
- **1 RED sturdy folder (no binders)** for Chinese class
- **1 STURDY (of your choice design) folder as the “Take Home Folder” (no red)**
- 5 rolls of scotch tape **in a plastic dispenser.** (\*\*Please write your name on all five of them.)
- 1 highlighter
- 1 **wood** ruler with inches and centimeters (**No metal rulers**) (Please write your name on the back.)
