Membership update-

• Cara self introduction- School counselor and parent, two daughters 3 and pre-k, been

with CPS 13 years and 4 years at OPS. Live and work in the community.

SEL update- Last Spring, the Equity COmmittee came to the SEL space. SEL does virtual

circle time. Culture and Climate joined PD with Rainbows. Looking to increase partnerships with

other outside opportunities. Rainbows- support group offered to all CPS students pre k through 12. Curriculum is research based. Candice and Cara are going through training (8hr) and will be certified to offer group. For students who have experienced a loss (divorce, death, etc.). They are being trained in how to do support groups for students (Sunbeam, rainbow) by grade band. Rainbows is broken down even further by grade. Candice and Cara will be co-facilitating groups of 10. Help students feel supported and not alone. Looking forward to offer groups via Google Meets starting in November. Behavioral Health Team (BHT) mental health professionals (counselors, social worker, vice principal, candice, nurse) creating a partnership with Advocate and other outside partners. Cara is teaching SEL classes for K-8 1 class a month- tier 1 support (all students) 30 min. Push in and provide supports in other ways. How will students be identified? Self survey and referral. Survey remote learning, do they want to participate in small group. Survey for 3-8 but k-2 is different. Meeting will be 1x/week for 12w. Asynchronous specials time is when services should ideally be held during remote.

Will parents be notified of the program for referral and Opt in/opt out

Is there a parent component? Possibly. Cara and Candice will do training this week and learn more soon.

Rainbows.org This is new to CPS but it has been running nationwide for years.

BHT- LSSI Lutheran social services of Illinois- they have a contract with CPS. OPS met with their team and BHT decided it would be a good addition to the school. One assigned social worker for the school for direct counseling during the school day or possibly after school (3-5pm). Paid through insurance or medicaid.

Report-out from LSC meeting- Al brought the report-out from the Equity Committee to the LSC meeting. The bylaws were proposed and will be discussed and voted upon at the next meeting. Brought our requests to the LSC meeting.

- Ambassador Program- We were approved to move forward on the Ambassador program for BAC students. Tim identified a need for an Albanian speaking interpreter because we have a new family at OPS who does not speak English. We planned to bring this request to this committee, but we were able to identify 3 people pretty quickly to help welcome this new family and acclimate them to the school.
- Indiginous People's Day- We presented the Google Spreadsheet to Tim and the LSC.
 Tim said he would update the school website calendar to include Indiginous People's day. Tim reported there were not any schoolwide plans to honor the day in any formal way.
- Bylaws- The bylaws were presented to the LSC for review. They will be voted on at the next meeting. Feel free to join and view the conversation.
- PD- Not yet but there will be PD this year.
