7. Principal's Report

- The Instructional Leadership Team is planning to ask teachers to work in randomly selected pairs to cooperatively plan a lesson to deliver before the end of the year. This is a part of our effort to address our CIWP goal of Teacher Collaboration and is an extension of the peer observations that teachers have been conducting.
- We are in the process of administering the IAR Assessment to all students in grades 3-8. Middle school students are finished, and 3rd -5th grade are testing over the next two weeks, completing testing by April 18.
- The social emotional theme for April is Global Citizenship. Students learn the importance of respecting the environment and taking care of the Earth.

- Our Climate and Culture team is working with a group of students to plan a second social emotional learning assembly for all students in May.
- The CTU and CPS reached an agreement last week. Once the agreement is ratified and the budget is finalized, we will know more about our budget for next year. This is later than it has been for the past several years, but we do expect to receive a budget in the next few weeks.
- Our overall attendance rate for the year is 93.53%, down from last month, compared to 93.22% at this time last year, with only 7th grade finishing above the 95% threshold.
- We have collected \$37,210 in Student Fees so far, up from 47% to 51% of students paid. Contacting families directly was effective at increasing the percentage, but we still face resistance. - We came up with a variety of strategies to improve this next year - i.e. Principal on the Roof, Tape the Principal to the Wall
- The OPS Drama Club presented Alice in Wonderland on March 18th - 20th. The shows were well received and well attended. It was an enjoyable experience for all.
- The 8th grade will take their annual trip to Washington DC next week, April 16-18.
- The Annual Spring Sing is scheduled for Wednesday, April 30.
